



Project 3-2 Clearwater Lake Access Improvement

Background: Existing access for Clearwater Lake is in poor condition and is too steep to reasonably launch a canoe.

Problem Statement: An alternative site to the existing public access to Clearwater Lake is needed to provide better access to the entire lake.

Goals: Acquire and develop carry down canoe access to Clearwater with a fishing pier and off road parking.
